KS3 students discussed the following...

### Issues

- Urinals smell
- Locks on cubicle doors are broken
- No soap dispenser
- Some students don't like using soap bars and think these are unhygienic
- Not enough individual cubicles
- No vacant/engaged door signs
- Silly behaviour by some students when in toilets
- Hot and cold taps have been switched

### Solutions & Ideas

- Remove Urinals
- More individual cubicles to replace urinals (minimum of 4)
- Door locks with engaged/vacant signs
- Soap dispensers fitted to wall
- Paint walls – colours suggested were green, yellow and blue
- Taps repaired
- New tiles and flooring
- Girls toilets to be freshly painted purple
- Girls toilets to be fitted with a full length mirror and a feminine hygiene box
