

Topic: Starwars

Mathematics

Students will develop their number skills and further investigate fractions.

- Number - building confidence in using all four basic operations and applying them to problems based on real world experiences – researching and budgeting for a Starwars model that students will plan, create and build.
- Fractions – understanding equivalence, adding and multiplying. Students will use their investigation skills to portion what each Starwars planet needs in order to survive.

PSHE

During this half term students will learn about road safety to ensure they keep themselves safe whilst out in the community. We will also learn and explore our emotional and mental health. This will include:

- Managing change, transition – settling into new class/group, getting to know you activities and zones of regulation.
- How to respond in an emergency (First aid, emergency numbers, who to ask for help in public)

Science

Students will explore all things Space.

Using our topic Starwars students will investigate the following:

- The names of all planets and their correct order
- The characteristics of planets
- The size and scale of the solar system
- Neil Armstrong – why is he famous
- Features of a rocket

Art

Students will investigate Sculpture and find out facts about famous artists in this field. Students will then make their own solar system using paper mache and will use different materials to bring it to life.

Design Technology

Students will alternate weekly between cooking and forest school. Students will focus on food hygiene and safety as well as chopping, mixing, frying, and baking using a range of equipment.

Music

This half term students will learn about classical composers. As a group we will explore the Starwars theme tune, who wrote the music and what instruments are used to play the song. Students will then be given the opportunity to create their own piece of music for their Starwars lego model advertisement.
