6 th Form Functional English	Students will be participating in a module about writing for a purpose. Within that they will be presenting their opinions about current topics of interest. They will write a review of a song, game or website and produce an advice leaflet on a chosen topic.
6 th Form Functional Maths	Students will be doing a lot of work around handling money. They will open a bank account and learn to update income and expenditure for the cafe. They will be exploring mobile phone deals and loans learning about how to make the best choices.
6 th Form ASDAN - PDP	Students will be doing work about the environment. They will present a study about an animal or historic building found in the North East. They will also explore the local area and visit Rising Sun Country Park - they will create a report including photographs and video.

6 th Form ASDAN Gardening	Students will be combining gardening and art as they look to improve the outlook of The Lodge. This will include making windchimes, art work and bunting.
6 th Form ASDAN Foodwise	Students will be learning about shopping on a budget and will explore the range of items sold at different supermarkets. They will continue to develop their cooking skills and become more independent when following recipes.
6 th Form Duke of Edinburgh Award	We will be focussing on the physical aspect of DofE. Students will be taking part in fitness sessions at our local gym where they will learn to use various equipment safely including exercise bikes and rowing machines. We hope that this experience develop maturity and independence to support a healthy lifestyle.
6 th Form Work Experience	Students will be reviewing the cafe menu for Spring. They will consult with staff to ensure they consider customer opinion. The maintenance group will be working together to complete maintenance jobs both inside and outside the school building. They will help to prepare the lodge and bungalow garden area.
