6 th Form Functional English	Students will be focussing on a functional curriculum. This term we will be learning about different styles of writing and developing our communication skills through discussion and persuasion. We will be researching holiday destinations and writing recounts and information texts.
6 th Form Functional Maths	Students will be learning about time and timetables. They will use these skills to plan a journey using public transport. They will be developing skills in number, place, value, multiplication and division within a practical context.
6 th Form ASDAN	Students will be exploring short courses to develop personal skills including independent travel. They will be encouraged to participate in personal learning and create a learning journal.
6 th Form Arts Award	Students will be exploring different art forms including music. They will participate in music workshops. They will also be exploring the work of artists and arts organisations.
6 th Form OCR Employability	Students will work on the module “Learn about managing money.” They will be focussing on how to manage money and how to avoid debt. They will be researching how people who experience debt can be supported.
6 th Form Duke of Edinburgh Award	Students will be working on the Volunteering section of the Duke of Edinburgh Award. They will be doing this through work experience opportunities.
6 th Form Work Experience	We have two work experience opportunities for students. Some will be working in the community café where we are developing our customer base and exploring different menus. We are also running a maintenance group to help support the upkeep of our lodge area as well as starting to develop our horticulture project. Individual students will be given the opportunity to explore personal work experience options.
PE	This term students will participate in a range of different activities from the gym to volleyball. Students are working towards increasing their fitness and completing the physical section of the DofE. PE kit needed on a Monday.
IT	This term students will be looking at computing in particular they will learn what an algorithm is and from there learn to activate a simple programmable toy through planning commands make something happen e.g. make a robot manoeuvre on a map.
Homework	Students will be asked to complete a reading journal at home showing evidence of different forms of reading.
