





Class CB Autumn 1 2025 Curriculum Overview

<p>History/Geography</p>	<p><u>Changes in Living Memory</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Exploring how life has changed over the past few decades through stories, photos, and interviews. ➤ Learning about toys, games, and technology from the past compared to today. ➤ Understanding changes in everyday life, such as school, transport, food, and clothing. ➤ Developing questioning skills by interviewing family members about their childhood. ➤ Building a sense of chronology and timelines to see how things have changed over time. ➤ Encouraging children to appreciate similarities and differences between past and present. ➤ Creating projects and presentations to showcase their learning about the past.
<p>PE</p>	<p><u>Team Games</u></p> <p>Over seven weeks, children will build teamwork, problem-solving, and critical thinking skills through fun activities such as Shoe Relay, Rescue, Maze, and Shipwreck, while gradually combining and reviewing concepts in the final weeks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Weeks 1 & 2: <i>Shoe Relay</i> and <i>Halves</i> – focusing on teamwork, coordination, and understanding parts and wholes. ➤ Weeks 3 & 4: <i>Rescue</i> and <i>Snakes</i> – developing problem-solving skills, agility, and creative thinking. ➤ Week 5: <i>Maze</i> – building navigation skills, critical thinking, and persistence. ➤ Weeks 6 & 7: <i>Shipwreck</i> and <i>Recap</i> – combining all skills learned, teamwork challenges, and review of key concepts.
<p>RE</p>	<p><u>Judaism:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Children will think about what’s important in their own lives and compare this with the values and beliefs that are important in Judaism. ➤ They will learn to recognise and name Jewish symbols, such as the Star of David and the menorah. ➤ They will explore key Jewish teachings, such as kindness, respect, and following the Ten Commandments. ➤ Children will learn about Jewish practices, including Shabbat (the day of rest) and dietary traditions like keeping kosher. ➤ They will discover important Jewish festivals, such as Hanukkah, Passover, and Rosh Hashanah, and understand why they are celebrated. <div data-bbox="1082 1451 1337 1704" data-label="Image"> </div>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ They will recognise and describe Jewish artefacts, such as the Torah scrolls, kippah (head covering), and mezuzah, learning about their purpose and meaning.
<p>Art / DT</p>	<p><u>Light and Dark:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Painting images related to our topic 'Light' and 'Dark'. ➤ Using different materials to create our work, such as tissue paper and charcoal. ➤ Discuss what each means to us.
