



A Guide to Using Seesaw- Remote Learning




Permission slips to use Seesaw have been sent home, once returned students will be given their code to access it.






You can now access your school and your class.



Any work assigned will be shown here in the activities section.






You can choose how to respond to the work. You can even use paper at home and then upload a photo.

3. Create your post. Edit your post to add voice recordings, drawings, text labels, or captions.






If a student accidentally closes the app or loses their work Seesaw will save the draft and it will be available next time the app is opened on the same device.


To confirm the upload, you must click the green tick.
